At Extendicare Falconbridge, we understand that each resident's quality of life depends on an approach to care that combines input from residents and family members with individual assessments from a team of trained caregivers. This approach ensures that support and care is tailored to meet the needs of each unique individual.

Our staff includes registered nurses; registered practical nurses; healthcare aides; restorative care aides; housekeeping and laundry aides; a kinesiologist; a social worker; and activationists to help, support and care for our residents. An experienced administrative team supports all of our healthcare staff.

Our home is warm, open, personal and pleasant. Extendicare Falconbridge has 20 private rooms, 59 semi-private rooms and 24 standard accommodation rooms. It's small enough to be intimate but large enough to provide a range of programs and services. Residents are encouraged to bring additional items such as bedspreads, pictures or knickknacks to personalize their rooms.

A home environment needs to be safe to feel secure, so at Extendicare Falconbridge there are call bells at each bed, in each washroom, and in all tub rooms. Our building is also completely equipped with heat and smoke detectors, and a two-stage fire alarm system with pull stations.

Our home includes:

- a beauty parlour
- an activity room
- a TV room

- a garden patio with walkways
- air conditioning in common areas, and
- a wander guard system

Our programs and services include:

- comprehensive and restorative exercise programs
- regular outings to points of interest
- extensive volunteer and community involvement
- a short stay program
- multi-denominational spiritual services and communion
- social programs such as pub with live music and tea groups
- intellectual stimulation with fun activities like quizzes and bingos
- emotional support with programs like pet therapy, one-to-one visit and touch therapy
